



6 LIGNUM

Lignum, the ancient Latin word for wood, is the inspiration behind this unexpected Italian blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz. The name pays homage to this element of nature that accompanies the wine as it matures over time.

Lignum is presented in a conical bordelaise bottle, reminiscent of the Bordeaux bottle's original shape and decorated with an authentic wood label embellished with cutouts which replicate wood grain and present an alluringly tactile element to this unique wine package. The outer shipper picks up the label design to further reinforce the wood aspect of the wine.

Tasting Note: Intense with an elegant body and balanced tannins, this wine is rich and persistent on the palate with jammy ripe cherry flavors, a hint of dark chocolate and notes of wood which culminate in a long finish.

Blend: 40% Merlot, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Shiraz
