THE VINEYARD

Crafted with fruit from one of the most highly-prized vineyards in Ala, Ca' Montini Pinot Grigio showcases the exceptional quality and winemaking history of Trentino. Comprised of three small plots that form a cone shape in the area called Valfredda, or Cold Valley, the Terre di Valfredda vineyard is protected from the elements by the surrounding mountains. The perfect east/west exposure and "Pergola Trentina" trellising system ensure that the conditions for ripening the fruit are ideal.

THE WINEMAKER

The entire vinification process is directed by Riccardo Cotarella, one of Italy's most celebrated winemakers, and his technical staff. Internationally acclaimed, Cotarella has been named Winemaker of the Year by Wine Enthusiast (2001), Best Italian Winemaker by Gambero Rosso (2001) and the Italian Association of Sommeliers (2002), and is acknowledged as "one of the best in Italian winemaking" by Wine Spectator and "one of the most influential wine personalities in the world" by Robert Parker Jr.

Excited by the challenge of creating a world class Pinot Grigio from Trentino, Cotarella has made manifest the extraordinary potential of Terre di Valfredda with Ca' Montini. Proof that with discerning site selection, meticulous vineyard management and world class winemaking this region can produce prestigious wines of authenticity and quality.
